**CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT CANDIDATES
TO PARTICIPATE IN LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS FORUM**

CONCORD, MA— Dale E. Brown (Independent), Bob Clark (Independent), Jon Golnik (Republican) and Niki Tsongas (Democrat), the four candidates for the Massachusetts 5th Congressional District seat, will face off in a forum sponsored by the League of Women Voters of Concord-Carlisle on Saturday, October 16, 2010.

The forum will begin at 3:00 p.m. in the auditorium of the Alcott Elementary School, 93 Laurel St., Concord, MA. The event is free and open to the public. The election will be held November 2, 2010.

Risa Nyman, former president of the League of Women Voters of Massachusetts, will moderate the forum. The moderator will ask each candidate to answer questions prepared by the League. Audience members will have an opportunity to submit written questions to the moderator.

LWV of Concord-Carlisle Co-President Paula Vandever noted, “It should be an exciting afternoon. Voters feel that the stakes are high this November for the country and for the direction of Congress, and they are eager to hear the candidates’ views.”
