Five candidates running for office in the March 29 Town Election have accepted the League's invitation to appear: Board of Selectmen candidate Jeff Wieand; School Committee candidate Pam Gannon; and Housing Authority candidates Anita Barker, Steve Newbold and K.C. Winslow. Town Moderator Eric Van Loon had to decline the invitation due to a prior commitment.

The candidates will answer questions from the League of Women Voters and audience members. Jo-Ann Berry of the Acton Area League of Women Voters will moderate the forum. Refreshments will be served.
